PROPOSED CRUISE TERMINAL AND **ALLIED FACILITIES**

- State of Art Terminal Buildings housing International Cruise Terminal and Domestic Cruise Terminal – Total: 9900sgm
- International Cruise Terminal will have 24 immigration counters, 10 check-in counters, waiting lounge, baggage carousel etc.
- Domestic Cruise Terminal will have 12 check- in counters, waiting lounge, baggage carousel, etc.
- Ancillary Commercial Building will have an experiential shopping zone aimed at Cruise Tourists and also made accessible to the general public - Total: 3700 sqm
- Other facilities- Duty free retail shops, lounges, food court, Ferry Terminal facilities, area for parking, landscaping and beautification, with internal road network and utilities, etc.
