## CIRCULAR

Under the International Maritime Organisation's MARPOL regulations, ports are required to provide waste reception facilities to vessels calling at port. In this connection, various measures have been taken such as provision of reception facilities for oily wastes and garbage. Companies receiving chemicals in bulk which fall under the category of Noxious Liquid Substances(NLS) have been asked by us to maintain separate earmarked tankages for the reception of Noxious Liquid Substance (NLS) wastes from their vessels.

The Directorate General of Shipping has conducted an audit for the waste reception facilities in our port. A Waste Management Plan is also under preparation. Keeping in line with the objectives of the plan and MARPOL regulations, information regarding ship generated wastes needs to be submitted to the port before the vessel's arrival.

Masters are required to submit this information at least 24 hours prior to arrival at Mormugao Port, as is done in the case of Pre-arrival Notification of Security (PANS). Agents are requested to inform the Masters, well in advance, so that Masters may submit the required information in the proper format, well in time.
