SUB: Deployment of a new NIOT Data Buoy **SW3** and retrieval of the old buoys SW3 & EB2

Please refer to our Harbour Notice No.08(temp.)2006 dated April 12, 2006., regarding deployment of NIOT data buoys SW3 & EB2. These buoys have been retrieved and the National Institute of Ocean Technology(NIOT) Chennai, has deployed 1 No. Data Buoy **(SW3)** on 21st May, 2006, in position: Latitude 15°23'39" N and Longitude 73°45'26" E (approx. Brg. 238° (T) x 2.3' from breakwater Lt)

The buoy is of 3m. dia, and **painted yellow.** It is fitted with 3m high mast, radar reflector and sensors . Buoy flashes **yellow light** every 5 seconds and is visible up to 4 nautical miles.

The data buoy collects and provides valuable information for prediction of weather conditions which is essential to improve safety of fishermen and vessels, operating in the area.

All fishing vessels, barges and all other vessels are directed "to pass the buoy by keeping a safe distance of at least 500m and not to anchor or trawl in the operation circle 500m of moored data buoy"
