### Circular No 09/2018.

Sub: Implementation of Penalty and Incentives Norms for Dry Bulk Cargo at Mormugao Port Trust (MoPT)

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The Board of Trustees, Mormugao Port Trust vide its Resolution No. 48 dated 30.08.2018 have approved the Penalty/Incentive Scheme applicable to Stevedores Operating at Mormugao Port Trust (MoPT). It has been forwarded to Ministry for approval and thereafter upon approval it shall be sent to Tariff Authority of Major Ports (TAMP) for implementation from the date of publication in Central Gazette. The proposed Penalty/Incentive Scheme of the Mormugao Port Trust for Stevedoring and Shore Handling operations will come into force once the Order is notified in the Gazette of India by TAMP.

This circular is issued for the information of the Members of the Trade and with a request to inform all the stake holders. The date of notification in the Gazette of India shall be separately intimated in the due course.

The proposal as approved is as below.

1. The **performance (productivity) norms** shall be stipulated as per the formula prescribed at para 4.1 and 4.2 of the policy guidelines issued by the Ministry. Basis the said formula, the prescribed performance norm for the dry bulk cargo handled at MoPT is as below:

## 2. The penalty/incentive linked with the performance, suiting the local constraints and restrictions:

If the ship stays upto 5% (higher or lower) of the stipulated time for that commodity as specified in			
productivity norms.	Nil		
Berth stay is more than 5% beyond the stipulated time for that Commodity as specified in productivity norms.	Rs 500/- per hour or part thereof for every additional hour.		
Berth stay is 5% lower than the stipulated time for that commodity as specified in productivity norms	Rs 50/- per hour or part thereof for every additional hour of saving in berth time beyond 5%		

Factors such as the delays that are attributable to the port viz., break-down/non-availability of port provided equipment, and weather related stoppages (tide, rain, rolling & pitching due to heavy wind, underwater currents, etc.) shall be considered as stoppages.
