Subject: "Maritime Trade Facilitation" -Mandatory Use of e-invoice. e-payment and eDelivery Order by all stakeholders in Maritime Trade - amendment – reg

In continuation of this Ministry's order of even No. dated 27th March, 2018 on the subject cited above, the undersigned is directed to say that after review of status with all the relevant stakeholders, it has now been decided to do the following to ensure smooth flow of sea-trade among the maritime community stakeholders.

- i. Issuance of e-Invoice, e-Payment and e-DO is mandatory irrespective of Portal providing these services.
 - ii. Shipping Lines may continue to use their present system/portals, third party solutions for carrying out e-invoice and e-payment till these facilities are fully ready in PCS;
 - iii. However, e-DO is to be submitted through PCS mandatorily;
 - iv. IPA shall develop all the required features for e-invoice and e-payment in the PCS portal by 15th May 2018.
 - v. Shipping Lines and other stakeholders shall extend full cooperation for implementing a complete solution through PCS portal by 15th May 2018.
 - vi. The status will be reviewed after 15th May 2018.
