Sub: Mandatory User Charges (MUC) of Delhi-Mumbai Industrial Corridor Development Corporation's (DMICDC) Logistic Date Bank (LDB) project - reg.

1. With reference to the Mandatory User Charges (MUC) charges in the Scale of Rates effective from 10.08.2019, the Tariff Authority For Major Ports (TAMP) vide Gazette No. 297 dated 21.08.2019 has approved levy of MUC for all containers (except transhipment and coastal) as tabulated below for (Delhi-Mumbai Industrial Corridor Development Corporation), DMICDC's Logistic Data Bank (LDB) project across all the Major Ports Trusts and BOT operators operating thereat:

3. The relevant para 11.1. (ii) of the Tamp order notified vide Gazette No. 297 dated 21.08.2019 is reproduced below for kind information of the Trade fraternity. "Insertion of the following provision in the Scale of Rates of all the Major Port Trusts and all the BOT terminals operating thereat governed by the 2008, 2013 and 2019 (erstwhile 20015) Guidelines for fixation of tariff.

"An amount of Rs. 155/- per container will be levied on all containers (except transhipment and coastal) handled at the Major Port Trusts and BOT terminals operating thereat towards Mandatory User Charge (MUC) for the Logistics Data Bank (LDB) service rendered by DMICDC for a period of one year thereon. On completion of one year thereafter, Rs. 165/- per container will be levied as MUC for the next period of one year. The approval accorded would automatically lapse thereafter unless specifically extended by the Authority."
