## TRADE NOTICE No.06/2021

## SUB: Liberalization of eligible conditions for DPD clearance - reg.

Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs (CBIC) has optimized its risk management using Artificial Intelligence (AI) techniques to increase the facilitation levels of import cargo to 90% from 15.07.2021 to clear more consignments immediately on arrival which will further increase the way for direct delivery from the Port and will cut down time and cost borne by the importers. Further to enhance more importers to avail the facility of DPD, eligible conditions for DPD clearance has been liberalized by CBIC to enable every consignment facilitate for Direct Delivery from the Ports. This is an ideal shift from entity based DPD to Customs Documents (Bill of Entry) based DPD which will not create any hindrance for importers to the present requirements of the Port/Terminal for availing DPD.

The Under Secretary, Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways, Government of India vide its letter No. PD-14033/47/2018-PD-V dated 30.07.2021directed all concerned to take active participation for effective implementation of the above initiative as well as sensitize concerned stakeholders in order to promote Ease of Doing Business.

Since MPT Goa is already achieving 100 % DPD/DPE, hence this notice is issued for the information of the Members of the Trade and with a request to inform all the stake holders.
