Sub: Ease of doing business: Exempting the cruise tourists arriving with e-visa from the requirement of biometric enrolment - reg.

As a step towards simplifying the procedures and as a part of ease of doing business, the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India have vide their Office Memorandum no 25020/75/2016-F.I (Vol V) dated 20.12.2017, has decided to exempt the cruise tourists arriving with e-visa at Ports of Mumbai, Cochin, Mormugao, Chennai and New Mangalore from the requirement of biometric enrolment, for a period of three years i.e., till 31.12.2020.
