
Mormugao Port Trust (MPT) Goa categorized under Tier-1 risk categorization for the Port. Significant cargoes handled at MPT are coal, ammonia and phosphoric acid fertilizer components, steel coil and slab, limestone, petroleum oil lubricants, molasses, and a small volume of containers.

Mormugao Port Trust intends to maintain the Oil Spill Pollution Response (OSPR) Equipments as per the amended National Oil Spill Disaster Contingency Plan 2015 edition, Circular ref. no. EP/07/20, dated 19th Dec 2018. Port has its own OSPR equipments, procured in May 2017 through M/s ENVIROCARE SYSTEMS, Mumbai and few short falling equipments needs to be acquired as per the above circular. The List of the existing and shortfall OSPRE equipment of the Port are enclosed as Annexure-I.

In view of the above you are requested to give the budgetary quotation for 10 year's Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract for 1) Operation and Maintenance of OSPRE equipment of the Port. 2) Providing short falling OSPR equipment on rent bases (as per enclosed list) along with required manpower. Terms and conditions

1. All the equipment should meet / exceed technical requirements mentioned by Indian Coast Guard.
2. Party should maintain all the main OSPR equipment mentioned at Annexure-I and its accessories which are mandatory for actual functioning of the equipment.
3. No extra cost will be paid to the party for spares and consumable items like Lubes, oils, fuels etc. which are required for operation and maintenance of the OSPR equipment.
4. Party has to bring his own container for storage of complete set of rental OSPR equipments.
5. Maintenance of the OSPR equipment and mock drills should be carried out as per the standard schedule provided by the Port.
6. For routine maintenance of the OSPR equipment minimum staff should be deployed on regular bases. However, for operation of the OSPR equipment mandatory staff should be made available within 24 hrs of notice (as per Annexure-I).
7. In case equipment requires repairs outside Port premises then contractor has to take all responsibility for transportation, also make the alternative arrangement of the similar equipment. Transportation charges shall be borne by the Contractor itself and handover the equipment within 30 days.
8. The power supply shall be provided by the Port free of cost for execution of the work; however, the Contractor shall take power supply from the nearest source by making suitable arrangements at their own cost and risk.
9. All tools and tackles and logistics involved in the work shall be arranged by the Contractor at their own cost. The transportation cost, if any, shall be borne by the contractor.
10. Necessary Entry passes shall be obtained by the Contractor at their own cost with prior approval of the Port Officials on Duty.
11. The works shall be carried out with due regard to safety standards prevailing in the Port.
12. The Bidders are advised to visit the site and get acquainted with the existing equipment, quantum of the work involved and site conditions.
