ADDITIONAL SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. The work shall be carried without disturbing the operation of Port or other agencies working in the area.
- 2. The Plant/machinery/craft and workman shall be insured during the work and receipts of payment made towards premiums shall be submitted to the Chief Engineer.
- 3. Bidders are advised to go through the Schedule of Quantities and Rates and sequence of work before submission of the tender. They are also advised to inspect the site, ascertain for themselves the nature and the extent of work involved and also obtain all clarifications they may require before filling in the tender.
- 4. Bidders are required to sign with date the Schedule of quantities and Rates and the form of Quotation and fill in all the particulars and details called for therein. Unsigned quotations, without the details called for are liable for rejection.

5. Measurements

The quantities provided for in the Schedule of Quantities and Rates are only approximate and are given to provide a common basis for tendering. The actual quantity may differ from those provided for in the Schedule in view of the complexity of the work. Payments will be made according to the actual quantities of work ordered and carried out, jointly measured by the representative of Chief Engineer and the contractor.

6. Rates and Prices to be inclusive.

The rates entered in the Schedule of Quantities by the contractor shall include the provision of all supporting special equipment, labour of required skill, supervision, materials, erection, overheads and profits, watch and ward, insurance charges, during execution and every incidental and contingent costs and charges, whatsoever, excluding service tax if any for compliance with conditions of contract and specification. The GST will be paid extra as applicable which shall be claimed along with the Bill.

7. The specifications are intended to cover the execution of all works, necessary to complete the works, with all materials of accepted standards, as specified in the contract.

8. Method of Measurement

<u>General</u>

Unless stated or billed otherwise, all quantities shall be 'net' as they finished and provided in the work. The rates and prices shall include all allowances towards wastage of materials required for use in the work.

- 9. The bidders will be deemed to have ascertained themselves to the extent and nature of the works involved, the various constraints and high degree of skill involved in the works.
- 10. The Contractor's supervisory staff shall be fully experienced in the type of work to be carried out under their supervision.
- 11. The contractor shall insure plant, machinery and workers employed by him during execution of work and submit necessary insurance policies to the Department. All the copies of insurance premiums related to the Workmen Compensation policy and Contractors All Risk policy should be submitted to the office of the Chief Engineer.
- 12. The time is the essence of the contract and as such the entire works shall be completed within the stipulated time.
- 13. If the work has to be carried out beyond normal working hours and during night time approval in advance for the working has to be obtained from the Chief Engineer. Overtime charges of the departmental supervisory staff has to be borne by the `Contractor`
- 14. It shall be specifically noted that the contractor is expected to mobilize the required equipments and work force required to complete the entire work included in the contract well within the stipulated period.
- 15. Water and electricity will be provided on chargeable basis subject to availability near the site of work. The charges will be as per the Port's scale of rates and have to be paid by the contractor.
- 16. As a statutory requirement, the contractor shall take all measures of safety against fire hazard and electrocution at site as follows:-
- All temporary electric supply connections will be carried out with correct sizes of wires/cables and fuses and other safety devices as required under Electricity Rules in consultation with us.
- b) One bucket full of water and sand shall be kept at the work spot. A Portable fire extinguisher shall also be kept at the work spot.
- 17. Quotations with conditions will be out rightly rejected.
- 18. The bidder shall inspect the site and fully study the work involved vis-à-vis the quantity and specifications etc. before quoting for the work.
- 19. The Contractor has to take care of any electrical or telephone cables. The contractor shall be liable to pay compensation for any damage to the Port property or its premises caused by the contractor or his workers.
- 20. After completion of day's work/contract period the contractor shall clean, clear the work site to the satisfaction of the Chief Engineer or his site representative.

- 21. The contractor shall communicate in writing name of all his workers and submit the photo identity card ,name ,address ,phone/contact number of the person to be deployed to work in the garden along with his Power of Attorney letter .
- 22. Permission for working beyond the normal working hours of the Port or on Sundays and Public Holidays as stipulated under clause No. 42 of General Conditions of Contract, (in the printed booklet) in volume-I of the tender document will be given to the contractor subject to his agreeing to bear the cost of overtime, if any, which may have to be paid to the Port's supervisory staff.
- 23. The contractor and his workers /agents shall be required to obtain from MPT and display a Photo Identity Card during entry, stay and exit from the Port Security areas guarded by CISF personnel`
- 24. All applications for issuance of Photo Identity Card shall be routed through the Chief Engineer, who shall forward the same to the Port's Traffic Department, whose pass section will issue the Photo Identity Card to the contractor free of cost and the same shall be valid for the duration of the contract or a period of one year, whichever is less.
- 25. Lease rent shall be charged to the contractor for the area allotted for construction of their temporary sheds site office/ store/ labour hutments required in the contract works. The license fee shall be as per Port's scale of rates.
- 26. The instruction given by the JE /Chief Engineer's authorized Representative /Officer in charge shall have to be carried out promptly. In case of any difference of option or interpretation on the specification and conditions, the matter to be referred to the Chief Engineer, for the decision, which shall be final and binding.
- 27. The bidder should comply with all regulations of EPF, ESI etc. No bill will be forwarded if the above regulations are not followed.
- 28. Payment of wages to the workmen to be paid in their respective Bank account.
- 29. GST registration for the bidder is mandatory. Bidder has to enclose attested copy of GST Registration No. along with the Quotation. GST has to be claimed extra as applicable while submitting the Bill/bills.
- 30. "The bidder shall quote the price exclusive of GST. Applicable GST shall be paid on the quoted price. The bidder shall indicate the applicable GST rate on goods/Services in the price bid"
- 31. Unregistered Venders under GST has to submit Declaration that GST is not applicable to him, due to turnover of less than 40 Lakhs.
- 32. The Vendor shall quote GST No. of MPT (30AAALM0293P1ZY) on all invoiced raised on Port. If vendor is not registered under GST or opted for composition scheme under GST, undertaking of the same shall be submitted by the Vendor.
- 33. The successful bidder shall have to furnish HSN /SAC Code for each items of the work.

SCOPE OF WORK:

The work put to the tender broadly comprises of the following items.

- 1. Dismantling doors, windows and ventilators, etc.
- 2. Dismantling and clearing away laterite brick or rubble masonry in c.m., etc.
- 3. Removing of Indian pattern W.C. and making good the floor with red oxide flooring, etc.
- 4. Removing and clearing away A.C. sheets in roofing, etc.
- 5. Constructing masonry in superstructure in partition walls 10 cms thick using precast cement concrete solid blocks having a crushing strength of not less than 35 kgs/m2
- 6. Constructing masonry in superstructure using precast cement concrete solid blocks having a crushing strength of not less than 35 kgs/m2
- 7. R.C.C. (1:11/2:3) mix using 20 mm graded black trap stone metal for lintels above doors, chajjas, etc.
- 8. Providing and fixing shuttering for lintels, continuous lintels, chajjas, etc.
- 9. Providing and fixing reinforcement for lintels, chajjas, etc.
- 10. Supplying and fixing paneled door with salwood frame, etc.
- 11. Supplying and fixing anodized aluminium fittings to doors, etc.
- 12. Supplying and fixing asbestos corrugated sheets 6 mm thick in roofing, etc.
- 13. Supplying and fixing A.C. plain adjustable ridges, etc.
- 14. Providing and fixing wash basin of vitreous chin 550 x 400 mm with all accessories, etc.
- 15. Supplying and fixing Indian pattern W.C. 580 mm size, etc.

- 16. Providing to the wall/floor etc. PVC pipes 12/15 mm thick
- 17. Providing and fixing in position brass bib cock 12/15 mm dia, brass stop cock 12/15 mm dia, etc.
- 18. Plastering with c.m. (1:3) 15 mm thick in single coat for 10 cms thick masonry works, etc.
- 19. Plastering external surfaces with c.m. (1:5) 15 mm thick in two coats for door edges, etc.
- 20. Painting woodwork with 2 coats of synthetic paint over a coat of pink primer, etc.
- 21. Distempering internal walls with dry distemper in two coats over a coat of primary whiting, etc.
- 22. Painting external walls with waterproof cement paint in two coats, etc.
- 23. Painting two coats with ready mixed paint for false ceiling, etc.
- 24. Supply of labour for cleaning the surrounding of the structure, etc.
- 25. Transporting and dumping the dismantled materials in the low lying area including loading, unloading, etc. as directed.
