Format and Signing of Bid

The Price Bid to be submitted on-line shall be signed digitally by a person or persons duly authorized to sign on behalf of the Bidders.

The Bid shall contain no alterations additions, except those to comply with instructions issued by Port.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ONLINE BID SUBMISSION

- 1. Bidders to follow the following procedure to submit the bids online through the e-tender site www.tenderwizard.com/MPT
- 2. Bidder should do the registration in the tender site using the '<u>Vendor Registration</u>' link available on home page.
- 3. Then the Digital Signature of SIFY/TCS/nCode or any Certifying Authority is to be registered after logging into the site.
- 4. Bidder can use 'Document Library' menu to uploadtechnical documents in advance as required for various tenders and use them during bid submission. This will facilitate the bid submission process by reducing time.
- 5. Bidder may get the tenders published documents in 'Tender free view' link in home page and download the required documents/tender schedules by free of cost for read only.
- 6. Bidder then login into the site using the secured log in by giving the user id/password chosen during registration and password of the DSC/e-token.
- 7. Only one DSC should be used for a bidder and should not be misused by others.
- 8. Bidder should read the tender schedules carefully and submit the documents as asked, otherwise, the bid will be rejected.
- 9. If there are any clarifications, this may be obtained using clarifications or during the pre-bid meeting. Bidder should take into account of the Addendum/Corrigendum's published before submitting the bids online.
- 10. Bidder must fill the bid documents to be submitted as indicated in the tender schedule and they should be use the uploaded format in website.
- 11. Bidder should prepare the EMD and tender fee as specified in the tender. While, the tender fee shall be paid through e-payment mode, the EMD shall be paid through e-payment mode, for amount upto Rs.5.00 lakhs, beyond Rs.5.00 lakhs EMD shall be in the form of Bank Guarantee and shall be submitted in electronic format through on line (by scanning) while uploading the bid. The EMD in the form of Bank guarantee in original shall be furnished to the CME, MPT, Goa, through post or by hand and shall reach on or before the bid opening date for the purpose of realization.

To claim exemption from EMD, exemption Certificate from SSI/MSME/NSIC or any empowered Central/State Govt. Authority shall be submitted in electronic format (by scanning) while uploading the bid.

However, either a Soft copy (scanned copy) or Hard copy of EMD/ EMD Exemption Certificate from SSI/MSME/NSIC or any empowered Central/State Govt. Authority&also e-payment of Tender Fee shall confirm the opening of the Technical Bid of the respective firms.

- 12. Bidder selects the tender which he is interested using Tender search option initially the tender will be available in vendor unapplied stage.
- 13. From vendor unapplied stage Bidder has to requested the tender document by clicking on Request tender form level-1 icon.
- 14. After requested the tender, same will move to vendor in progress.
- 15. The bidder has to select 'Edit Attachment Level 1' icon under action menu of particular tender.
- 16. The Bidder has to enter the password of the DSC/e-token and the required bid documents have to be uploaded one by one as indicated.
- 17. The vendor has to quote the rates in provided excel sheet (BOQ) by filling the highlighted in blue color cells and should be updated. The BOQ document, if found modified by the bidder, his bid will be rejected.
- 18. The tendering system will give a successful bid updation message & then a bid summary will be shown with the bid no. & the date & time of submission of the bid with all other relevant details. The bidder has to submit the relevant files required as indicated in the cover content. In case of any irrelevant files, the bid will be rejected.
- 19. The bid summary has to be printed and kept as an acknowledgement as a token of the submission of the bid.
- 20. The bid summary will act as a proof of bid submission for a tender floated and will also act as an entry point to participate in the bid opening date.
- 21. For any clarifications with the Tender Inviting Authority (TIA), the bid number can be used as a reference.
- 22. Bidder should log into the site well in advance for bid submission so that he submits the bid in time (i.e.) on or before the bid submission time. If there is any delay, due to other issues, bidder only is responsible.
- 23. Each documents to be uploaded online for the tenders should be less than 5 MB. And BOQ and Technical bid should be less than 2 MB. If any document is more than 5 MB, it can be reduced by scanning at low resolution and the same can be uploaded.
- 24. The time settings fixed in the server side & displayed at the top of the tender site, will be valid for all actions of requesting, bid submission, bid opening etc., in the e-tender system. The bidder should follow this time during bid submission.
- 25. All the data being entered by the bidders would be encrypted using PKI encryption techniques to ensure the secrecy of the data. The data entered will not viewable by unauthorized persons during bid submission & not be viewable by any one until the time of bid opening.

- 26. The confidentially of the bids is maintained since the secured Socket Layer 128 bit encryption technology is used Data storage encryption of sensitive fields is done.
- 27. Any documents that is uploaded to the server is subjected to symmetric encryption using a generated symmetric key. Further this key is subjected to asymmetric encryption using buyers public keys. Overall, the submitted tender documents become readable only after the tender opening by the authorized individual.

- 1.5 TheBidder isexpectedtoexamineallinstructions,forms,terms,and specifications in the Tendering Documents. Failure to furnish all information or documentation requiredby theTendering Documents may result in the rejection of the Tender.

1.7. BIDDER TO INFORMHIMSELFFULLY

- a. TheBidder is expected to examine carefully the contents of the tender document like Instructions to theBidders, General Conditions, Special Conditions, Scope of work, Technical Specificationetc.Failuretocomplywiththerequirementsofthetenderwillbeat the Bidder's ownrisk.It would be deemed prior to the submission of the tender that the Bidder has made a complete and careful examination of requirements and other information set out in the tender document including inspection of site.
- b. TheBidderisadvisedtogetacquaintedhimselfwiththejobinvolvedat the site, like availability of labour, means of transport,communication facilities, laws andbye laws

in force from Government of Goaand Govt. of India and any other Statutory bodies as well as MPT regulation for theissue of passes and collectall information that may be necessary for preparing and submitting the tender and entering into Contract with MPT.

The BG shall be submitted in electronic format (by scanning) while uploading the bid and the original Bank guarantee shall be furnished to the CME, MPT, Goa, through post or by hand and shall reach on or before the date of opening of the bid for the purpose of realization.
- 1.8.2. To claim EMD exemption of the tenderers are required to produce an attested copy of the NSIC registration Certificate issued in the name of the firm who will submit the tender document. The exemption from the payment of EMD will be allowed only if similar work of the tender match with the enlistment statement shown in the Certificate issued by SSI/MSME/NSIC or any empowered Central/State Govt. Authority. No claims for exemption without the details stipulated above will be considered. The SSI/MSME/NSIC or any empowered Central/State Govt. Authority or any empowered Central/State Govt. - b. The amendment socarried out shall form part of the tender and shall be bindingupontheBidders. MPTmayattheirdiscretion, extendthe last date for submission of the tender, to enable the Bidders to have reasonable timetosubmit theirtenderaftertaking intoconsideration such amendments.

1.13. TEST OF RESPONSIVENESS

- c. The Auditor's report for the last three years endorsed by Chartered Accountant shall be submitted in electronic format in original for the year 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17) as per Appendix, along with relevant profit and loss statements and balance sheets.

Suchomissionshallnotberelatedtoanyaspectofthe priceoftheTender. FailureoftheBiddertocomplywiththerequest may result in the rejection of its Tender.

1.15. OTHER EXPENSES

- b. Exceptwhereotherwiseexpresslyprovided,theContractorshallprovideall materials, labour and Plant and things necessary in connection with the Contract work although everything may not be fullyspecified and although there may be errors and omissions in the specifications.

c. SCHEDULE OF PRICE

- The Schedule of price/BOQ shall be read in conjunction with all other sections of biddingdocument.
- Thepriceoffered should be firm and exclusive of all taxes &duties which will be paid extra as applicable. However, any new tax will be imposed by State/Central Govt. and same will be reimbursed on producing documentary proof.
- d. Biddershallquotefortheworkaftercarefulanalysisofcostinvolvedforthe performance of the works as per Scope of Work, Scope of Supply, Specifications, Standards, Drawings, General Conditions of Contractand Special Condition of Contract.
- e. The Price shall include all expenditure in curred towards mobilization and demobilization.
- f. Price shall be quoted in Indian Rupees only.

1.17 LANGUAGE OF TENDER

The Tender submitted by the Bidder and all correspondence and documents relatingto the Tender exchanged by the Bidder and MPT shall be written in the English language.

1.18 PRE-BID CONFERENCE

MPT shallholdapre-bidmeeting,inordertoclarifyanddiscussissues withrespect to the tender vis-à-vis termsandconditions oranyother related issues. The meeting shall be held at Conference Room, Office of the Chief Mechanical Engineer, A.O. Bldg.,MPT, Headland Sada 403 804 as per NIOT. Bidders areadvised to forward theirqueries to the ChiefMechanicalEngineer,MPT,onorbefore the scheduled date of the pre-bid meeting. If there are any further queries after Pre-Bid Conference, the same shall be submitted within the due date which will be indicated during Pre-Bid meeting. No queries will be entertained after this due date. Thequeries received from all the prospective Bidders would be consolidated and Port's clarification to the same would be uploaded on the website. The clarifications so is sued would form part of the tender and remain binding on all the Bidders which shall be accepted and submitted by all the Bidders along with their offer.

1.19 TENDER OPENING, SCRUTINY AND EVALUATION OF TECHNICAL BID

ATenderthatissubstantiallyresponsiveis thatwhich conformstothe precedingrequirementswithoutmaterialdeviationorreservation. A materialdeviationorreservation isone(1)whichaffectsinany substantialway, the scope, quality, or performance of the Bidder, or (2)which limits in any substantial way, inconsistent with the Tenderdocument, or (3) whose rectification would affect unfairly the competitive position of other Qualified Applicant presenting substantially responsive bids.

Sincethetender involvesselectionbasedonMinimumeligibilitycriteria, test of responsiveness andtechnicalspecification,theChiefMechanicalEngineerwillexamine andseekclarification ifanyandlistoutthefirms,whicharefound responsive andBOQofsuch tendersonlywillbe openedandEMDwillbereturnedtotheunresponsiveBidders.

ThedateandtimewillbeintimatedtoBidderswhoseoffersarefound suitableandBOQof suchBidderswillbeopened.

After the tender opening, the whole process involving clarifications, scrutiny, of evaluation and comparison tenders and recommendationsregardingawardofContractshallbeconfidential. Any efforts on part of any Bidder toinfluence the PortTrust in any way in the process of scrutiny, evaluation, comparison tenders and concerningawardofContractmayresultinrejectionoftheBidder's bid.

Toassessthescrutiny, evaluation and comparison of tenders, the Port

Trust may ask Bidder in dividually for clarifications. Request for clarification and response thereto, shall be in writing or through e mail followed by postor through speed post. No change in Price or substance of the tender shall be sought, offered or permitted or is the Bidder permitted to with draw the tender before the expiry of the validity period of the tenders in the process of clarifications.

1.20 OPENING OF PRICE BID (BOQ)

The date of opening of the BOQ will be intimated to the bidder who will qualify for technical cover. PriceshouldbequotedasperBOQ.

1.21 EVALUATION OF PRICE BID

- a. The price quoted by the biddershall be kept firm during the contract period. Insurance shall be included in the quoted price whereas all taxes will be extra as applicable.
- b. MPTwillevaluateandcompareonlythosebids, which are substantially responsive.
- c. The pricequotedbytheBiddershallbeconsideredforthepurposeof evaluation and comparison.
- d. In arriving at thefinal evaluated prices of theTenders, any uncalled for lumpsum/percentage/or adhocreduction, if any, offered by the Bidders, inthe Schedule ofPriceshallbe considered forthe purpose of evaluation. However, if such reduction/rebate is from therecommended Bidder, then suchrebate shall be taken into account while awarding the work.
- e. In arriving at the final evaluated prices of the bidders, evaluation of offer will be based on the lowest price quoted.

1.22MPT'S RIGHT TO ACCEPT OR REJECT A BID

MPTreserves the right to accept a Bid other than the lowest and to accept or reject any Bid in whole or part, to annul the bidding process or to reject all Bids with or without notice or reasons. Such decisions by MPTshall bear no liability whatsoever consequent upon such decisions.

1.23 AWARD OF CONTRACT

The Bidder, whose Bid is accepted by MPTshall be issued Letter of Acceptance (LOA) prior to expiry of Bid validity. Bidder shall confirm acceptance by returning a signed copy of the LOA. MPTshall not be obliged to furnish any information/clarification/ explanation to the Contractors as regards non-acceptance of their Bid.

CHIEF MECHANICAL ENGINEER MORMUGAO PORT TRUST

SECTION - II

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION

1.0 GENERAL

There are around 42 Nos high Masts in the Port area including Headland, MOHP and Railway signaling Yard which provide illumination at the operational areas. With the handing over of berth no. 8, 9 & barge unloader jetties to M/s. Goa Sea Port Pvt. Ltd., 13 nos. of high masts have become redundant.

As part of the Sagarmala project, Port is expanding railway line and constructing 30 mtr. wide platform at Railway yard due to which 7 nos. High masts are required to be installed for illuminating the area. It was decided that since the basic structure of the existing High masts in MOHP area is in good condition, same should be reused by refurbishing the accessories.

Accordingly one No 30 mtrs High mast (HM No 7 Bajaj make) with accessories from OEM M/s Bajaj Electricals was refurbished on trial basis without disturbing the existing foundation

The pilot project wassuccessful and it has been inspected and found working satisfactorily. It is now proposed to refurbish additional 6 Nos additional 30 mtrs high masts (3 Nos Bajaj make i.e. HM 5,6& 20 and 3 Nos Albabtain make i.e HM 43,44,45) and install the same in the Railway platform area.

The accessories required for the additional 6 Nos High Masts will be procured from OEM M/s Bajaj Electricals thro' MM Division and handed over to the Party for refurbishing the Highmasts. It is now proposed to refurbish and install total of 7 Nos Highmasts out of which one no is already refurbished as a pilot model.

Balance 9 Nos Highmasts in MOHP area will be dismantled and removed after completion of Operational activities at Berth No 8 and 9.

2.0 SCOPE OF WORKS:

The work involves:-

- 1. Dismantling of existing 5 highmasts (HM No 5, 6, 7, 20 and 43) with all accessories from the RCC foundation and shifting to Railway yard. 2 Highmasts i.e. No 44 and 45 in Railway yard area have already been dismantled. High mast No 7 is already refurbished.
- 2. Removing of existing fittings from 5 Nos High masts, Head frame, winch drum, trailing cable, wire rope from the highmast and shifting the Highmast to Railway Yard. Old fittings and accessories are to be shifted to location indicated by Port Engineer.
- 3. Installation of new Head frame, double lantern carriage, Double drum winch, 5 core X 4 sqmm. trailing copper cable, SS wire rope 8 mm supplied by the Port on HM 5,6,7,20, 43,44 and 45 and handing over to Port for Installation. (All accessories required for refurbishing of Highmast will be supplied by the Port.)
- 4. Supply of foundation bolts, templates and anchor plates suitable for 4 Nos Bajaj make 30 mtrs Highmats and 3 Nos Albaktain make Highmats for making the foundation.
- 5. The bidder shall inspect the site and assess the work involved in detail and ensure that the items are suitable for the respective High masts. The bidder shall take into account any fittings, accessories, apparatus, modifications or any other works not specifically indicated in the tender but otherwise essential for overall completion of the work before submitting his offer and the same shall be deemed to have been included in the scope of supply. All the work shall be carried out as directed by Engineer in charge. However, the work shall be executed as per IER, relevant IS, Safety and prevailing statutory regulations.
- 6. Work on Highmasts No. 5, 6, 7, 20, 43,44 and 45 will be taken up in 1st Phase. Highmasts No 16,17,18,19, installed alongside Berth No 8/9 and Highmasts No8, 9,10,11,12alongside barge Unloader Jetties shall be dismantled in second phase at a later date after stoppage of Operations at Berths No 8 and 9 as per the instructions of Port Engineer.

SECTION - III

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT (GCC)

3.1 <u>DEFINITION AND INTERPRETATIONS</u>

In the Contract, ashereinafter defined,the following wordsand expressions shallhavethemeaningsherebyassignedtothemexcept wherethecontext otherwise requires:

- a. "MPT"or"Port"or "PortTrust",meansthe BoardofTrusteesof MORMUGAO PORTTRUST"ortheirsuccessorsandassigns,actingthrough its Chairman or any other officer so nominated by the Board.
- b. "Engineer"meanstheChiefMechanicalEngineer(CME)oftheMormugaoPort Trust orthe officer authorized by him to act for and on his behalf.
- c. Engineer-in-Charge: Officer appointed by Engineer to be in charge of the execution of work.
- d. "Contractor"meansthenaturalperson,privateorGovernmententity,ora combination of theabove, whoseTender to perform the Contract has been acceptedbythePortandisnamed assuchinthe ContractAgreement or his representative who is duly authorized to deal with the contract.
- e. "Sub-Contractor"meansanynaturalperson, private or governmententity, or a combination of the above, to whom any part of the goods to be supplied or execution of any part of related services is subcontracted by the Contractor under intimation to the Port.
- f. "Contract" means and includes Tender Documents, Instructions to Bidders, GeneralConditions of Contract,SpecialConditions,ifany, drawings, specifications, Price Schedule and Schedules etc., any amendments/clarificationsthereto,Letter ofAcceptance (LOA)and the ContractAgreemententeredintobetweenMPT andtheContractor.
- g. "Contract Documents" means the documents listed in the Contract Agreement,

- including any amendments there to.
- h. "ContractPrice"meansthepricepayabletotheContractorasspecifiedin the Contract Agreement, subject to suchadditions and adjustments thereto or deduction there from, as may be made pursuant to the Contract.
- "Specification"meansthespecificationreferredtointheTenderdocument andanymodificationthereoforaddition theretoasmayfromtimetotimebe furnished or approved in writing by the Port.
- j. "Site" means the land and other places on, under, in, or through which the work is to be executed or carried out and any other lands or places provided by the Board for the purpose of the Contract together with such other places as may be specifically designated in the Contract as forming part of the site.
- k. "Works" means the works to be executed in with the Contract.
- I "Approved/Approval" means the approval in writing.
- m. "Engineer-In-Charge" means any Officer authorized byChiefMechanical Engineer for the work.
- n. "Drawings" means the drawings referred to in the Specification and any modification of such drawings approved in writing by the Engineer-In-Charge.
- o. "Tests on completion" shall mean such tests as are prescribed by the applicable Design Standards(latest editions),codesand described in the tender document, to be made by the Contractor before the equipment / items are supplied, delivered and taken over by the Port.
- p. "Writing" shall include any manuscript, typewritten orprintedstatement under or over signature and seal as the case may be.
- q. "DefectLiabilityPeriod"hasthemeaningassignedintheclauseNo.3.26of the tender document.

- r. "Month" means calendar month.
- s. "Day" means calendar day.
- t. "LetterofAcceptance (LOA)"meanstheformalacceptance,madebyoronbehalfof the Port,ofthetenderincludinganyadjustmentsorvariationtothe tender agreed between the Port and the Contractor.
- u. "Foreign currency" means the currency other than Indian Currency.
- v. "CommissioningofEquipment"hasthemeaningassignedinclauseno.3.30.i of the tender document.
- w. "Tender" means the offer of the Contractoralongwithallotherrelevant documents as referred to in the Contract.
- x. "RelatedServices"meanstheservicesincidentaltothesupplyof thegoods, such as insurance, installation, training and initial maintenance and other such obligation of the Contractor under the contract.

3.2 SINGULAR AND PLURAL

Wordsimplyingthesingularonlyalsoincludethepluralandviceversa where the context required.

3.3 **HEADINGS OR NOTES**

The headings in these conditions of Contract and instructions to tenders shall not be taken to be part thereof, or be taken into consideration in the interpretation, or construction thereof, or of the Contract.

3.4 <u>ENGINEER-IN-CHARGE AND HIS REPRESENTATIVE</u>

- a. The Engineer-In-charge shall carry out such duties in issuing decisions, certificates and orders as specified in the Contract.
- b. The Engineer may from time to time, inwriting delegate to his Representative any of the powers, discretion, function and/or authorities vested in himandhe may at any time

revoke any suchdelegation. Any written decision, instruction or approval given by the Engineer to the Contractor in accordance with suchdelegation shall bindthe Contractor provided always that:

- AnyfailureoftheEngineertodisapproveanyPlantworkmanship shallnotprejudicethepoweroftheEngineerthereaftersuch Plant or workmanship and to order the rectification thereof in accordance with these conditions;
- ii. IftheContractorshallbedissatisfiedbyreasonofanydecisionofthe Engineerheshallbeentitledtoreferthemattertotheofficer abovetherankwho willthereuponconfirm,reverseorvary suchdecision, and the same shall be final and not arbitrable.
- iii. WhereverbytheseconditionstheEngineerisrequiredtoexercise his discretion, by giving a decision, opinion, consent or to express satisfactionorapproval,or to determinevalueorotherwisetakeaction which may affect the rights and obligations of the Contractor, the Engineer shall exercise such discretion fairly within the terms of the Contract and having regard to all the circumstances. If eitherparty disagreeswiththeactiontakenbythe Engineer heshallbeat libertytoreferthe mattertoAppellate Authoritywiththese conditions,and the same shall be final and not arbitrable.

3.5. OBLIGATIONS OF THE CONTRACTOR

- a. The Contractor shall exercise all reasonable care and diligence in the dischargeof all technical, professional andcontractualdutiestobe performed by themunder this Contractas specified in the Scope of Work withinthe Time for Completion and provide all labour, including the supervision and security thereof, Contractor's Equipment necessary thereof andforcarryingouthisobligation, sofaras thenecessity for providing the same is specified in or is reasonably to be inferred from the Contract. The Contractor shall be fully responsibletoMPTfor proper, efficient and effective discharge of their duties.
- b. ContractorshallfurnishbondintheformofBankGuaranteetowards the performance of the work as per clause 3.30 of this tender document.
- c. IfthePortshallconsider himself entitledtoanyclaimunderthe PerformanceGuaranteeheshallforthwithsoinformthe Contractor specifying the default

of the Contractor upon which herelies. If the Contractor fails to remedy such default within 30 days after the receipt of suchnoticethePortshallbeentitledtoforfeittothe extentof the loss or damage incurred by reason of the default.

d. TheContractorshallproceedwiththeWorksinaccordancewiththe decisions, instructions and orders given by the Engineer in accordance with the condition of the Contract.

3.6 ASSIGNMENT ANDSUBLETTING

- a. The Contractormay submit the details of subletting. However the final decision will be made by MPT authority.
- Heshallneitherassignhisrightandinterestinthispresenttender norassumea freshpartnerorpartners, ordissolvethe partnership existing between him in reference to this Contract without the written permission of MPT.
- C. Intheeventofany activitybeingsub-contracted,thetotalliabilityand responsibilityformeeting obligationsand performance under Contract AgreementshallrestwiththeContractor. Intheeventofthe Contractor contraveningthis condition, the Portshall be entitled to terminatethe ContractforthwithandawardafreshContracttosomeotherpartyat risk and cost of the Contractor who shall be liable forany loss or damage which the Port may sustain in replacementoftheContractor.Insuch consequence arisingout of such casethePerformanceGuarantee shall be forfeited.
- d. Such consent, if any, shall not relieve the Contractor from any liability or obligations under the Contract and he shall be responsible for the acts, defaults and neglects of any Sub-Contractor or his servants, agents or workmenfullyiftheyweretheacts, defaultsorneglectsof the Contractor provided always that the provisions of labour or a piecework basis shall not be deemed to be sub-letting under this clause.

3.7 PATENT RIGHTS

a. The Contractor shall fully indemnify the Port againstany action, claimordemand, costsor expenses arising from or incurred by reason of any infringement or alleged infringements of letters, patents, Design, trademark or name, copyright or other protected rights in respect of any machine, Plant, work, materials or things, system or methods of using, fixing working or arrangement used for fixed or supplied

by the Contractor in India, or elsewhere.

- b. All payments, or otherwise shall be deemed to be included by the ContractorinthePricesnamedinthe tenderandshallbe paidbyhimto whom they may be payable.
- C. IntheeventofanyclaimbeingmadeoractionbroughtagainstthePort inrespect such matter as aforesaid, the Contractors hall be immediately notified thereof and he shall. with the assistance requiresofthePort,butatthesoleexpenseoftheContractor,conduct all negotiations for the settlement of thesame or any litigation that may arise from, provided that the conduct of suchnegotiationsorlitigationsshallbe conditionalupontheContractor giving to the Port such security as shall from time to time, reasonably requiredby the Port to recover ascertained agreed or amountasthecasemaybeofanycompensation,damages,expenses andcostwhichmightbepayablebyTrusteesinrespectof orasresultof any negotiation or litigation.

3.8 GENERAL OBLIGATION OF THE PORT

In execution of the Works no person other than the Contractor, sub-Contractorsandhisandtheiremployeesshallbeallowedon thesiteexcept bythewrittenpermissionoftheEngineer InChargeor his authorized representative, but the Engineerincharge,his authorized representative, other authorities and officials of MPT shall be afforded to inspect all facilities arranged by the Contractor at site.

3.9 FRAUD AND CORRUPTION

The Port as well as Bidder, Contractor, Sub-Contractor and Consultants observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of such contracts. In pursuit of this policy, MPT:

- a) Defines, for the purpose of this provision the terms set for the low as follows:
- (i) "Corruptpractice"meanstheoffering, giving, receiving or soliciting, directly or indirectly of anything of value to influence the action of a public official in the procurement process or in contract execution; and
- (ii) "Fraudulent practice" means a misrepresentation or omission of facts in order to

influence a procurement process or the execution of a contract;

- (iii) "Collusive practice" means a scheme or arrangement between two or more Bidders designed to establish Tender prices at artificial noncompetitive levels and;
- (iv) "Coercive practice" means harmingor threatening to harm directly or indirectly, persons or their property to influence their participation in the procurement process or affect the execution of a contract;
- b) Will black listafirm or individual, including declaring them ineligible either indefinitely or for a stated periodof time to be awarded, if it at any time determines that they have, directly or through an agent engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive or coercive practice in competing for, or executing and;
- c) Will have the right to enquire that Contractor to permit the Port to inspect their account and records andother documents relating to the Tender submission and contract performance.

3.10 COMPLETION PERIOD OF WORK

The work shall be completed within 10weeks from 7th day of issue of LOA applicable only for activities under Sr Nos 2 and 3 of the BOQ .However for part of activity under Sr no 1 of BO (HM No 16,17,18,19, and Highmasts No 8, 9,10,11,12,) the work shall be completed in all respects within 2 weeks from the date of handing over the site to the contractor .

3.11 RATES AND AMOUNTS INCLUDE ALL CHARGES

The rates and amounts submitted by the Biddershall include all payments on account of,levies,duties,royalties,etc.,payable to the StateofGoaorGovernmentof IndiaoranyotherauthorityorBody

CorporateandallotherincidentalchargesthattheBiddermayhaveto bear for the execution of the Works. The Bidders shallmake their own arrangements to ascertain the applicable rates in respect of Central Excise Duty from the concerned Govt. Authorities. However any other Taxes will be paid extra as applicable.

3.12 ADDITIONS AND ALTERATIONS

a. MPTmaygiveinstructionsanddirectionsasmayappear(necessary andproper) for the

guidanceoftheContractorand goodandefficient execution of the Works under this contract without altering major conditions and scope of work of the Contract.

b. TheContractorshallreceive, obeyand be bound by the same according to the true intent and meaning thereof.

3.13 EXECUTION

The Contractorshall,in consideration ofpayments to be made to himas herein after provided, execute and do the Works set forth as described in the scope of the work and specifications, including any amendments to tender clauses.

BiddersshouldobtainGate passesfromMPTTraffic Manager at Main Admin Building, thirdfloor, Mormugao Port Trust, Headland Sada, Vasco 403 802togainentryintotheTrust's premisesifnecessary.

3.14 **SECURITY DEPOSIT**

- (i) The contractor shall within 30 days from the date of LOA, shall furnish aDD from Nationalized/Scheduled Banks in favour of the Financial Advisor & Chief Accounts Officer, MPT, payable at Vasco, Goa, towards Security Deposit. This Security Deposit will be converted to Performance Guarantee upon completion of the work.
- (ii) Security deposit shall consist of two parts:
 - a) The DD equivalent to 5% of the contract value rounded off to nearest 100 rupees, shall be submitted within 30 days of issue of Letter of Acceptance
 - b) The balance 5 % shall be recovered as Retention Money from the running bills. Thereafter, the total of 10%(DD 5% and 5 % Retention money) shall be returned after completion of Guarantee period of 1 year.
- (iii) On receipt of full deposit as arrived above in any manner aforesaid the Earnest Money submitted with the Tender will be refunded/ BG towards EMD discharged. No interest will be allowed on the earnest money from the date of its receipt until it is refunded. In the case, however for unsuccessful Tenderers, Earnest Money will be refunded, as soon as possible after the finalisation of L1 of the contract. Alternatively the successful Tenderer shall when his tender is accepted, furnish Earnest Money. The Earnest Money shall retain its character as such, till the Security Deposit is furnished by the Tenderer.

(iv) Forfeiture of SD:The security deposit will be forfeited, if the contractor fails to fulfill any or all the conditions of this contract, without any interference from it towards all rights of the Board to recover from the contractor any other amounts falling due to the Board through non-observance/compliance by the contract conditions and any of the clause thereof by the contractor.

3.15 SIGNING OF AGREEMENT

- (i) TheContractorshallexecuteanAgreementwiththeTrustwithin45days from the date of receipt of LOA. If the Contractor, whose tender has been accepted,failsto execute anAgreement within45 days from the date of receipt ofdocuments for execution of the Agreement, the Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) deposited by theBiddershall be forfeited and the Biddershallnotbeallowedfurthertoparticipatein the Trust's tenders.
- (ii) The cost of stamping the contract Agreementandcost of preparation of contract document (1 original + 4 copies)must be borne by the successful Bidder. Stamp paper of Rs.1000/- shall be from the Local authorized vendor in Goa for the purpose of contract agreement.
- (iii) The place of stamping and signing of Agreement shall be at MPT only.
- (iv) Further,ifthesuccessfulContractorundertakes,toenterintoandexecute, when called upon to do so, an Agreement, with such modifications as agreed upon and unless and until the formal Agreement is prepared and executed, thesuccessful Contractor'soffer,Trustorderandthewritten acceptancefor the receipt of Trustorder of the successful Contractor shall form a binding Contract between the Trust and the Contractor.

The ContractAgreementshallincludeamendedfinaltender document,pre- bid queries, various clarification letter, written approvalby the Trust authorities, Amended to the Contract Agreement and any other conditions as agreed upon by the Trust and the Contractor.

3.16. PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE (PG)

i.) The aforesaid Security Deposit (Clause 3.14) will be converted to Performance Guarantee upon completion of the work applicable only for activities under Sr Nos 2 and 3 of the BOQ ,validity of such Guarantee issued, towards performance of the Contract, shall be for a period of one year from the date of successful commissioning and testing of the installation, with a claim period of 2 months thereafter.

3.17 EXTRA WORK (VARIATION)

AnyextraexpensesincurredinconnectiontotheWorksbyMPT inthe performanceoftheWorksowingtotheneglectoromissiononthepartof the Contractor, in any of the case mentioned in this Contract shall be deducted from anysum due or whichmay thereafter become due to the Contractororfromanyamountlyingwiththemorunder theircontrolorhe maybecalledupon topaytheamountof suchextraexpensetosuchperson or persons as MPT may appointtoreceive the same and in the eventof theContractorfailingtomake suchpayment,thesaidamountshallbe recoverable from him in such manner as MPTmay determine.

However, the quantity variation shall be altered ±30%

3.18 CONTRACT DOCUMENTMUTUALLYEXPLANATORY

- a. TheseveraldocumentsformingtheContractaretobetaken asmutually explanatory of one another and should anything appear in one that is not described in the other, no advantage shall be taken of any such omission.
- b. In case of any discrepancies or inconsistencies however appear, or shouldanymisunderstandingsariseastothemeaning andofthe specificationsordrawingsorastothe dimensionsorthequalityofthe materialorproperexecutionoftheWorksorasto themeasurementor quality and valuation of the Worksexecuted under this Contract or as extrathereupon, the same shallbeexplainedbytheEngineer-in-charge or his authorized representative.
- c. The explanation of Engineer-in-charge or his authorized representative shall be final and binding upon the Contractor and the Contractor shall execute the Works according to such explanations, and without extra charge or deductions to / from the Prices specified in the bill of quantities and do all such Works and things as may be necessary for the proper

completionoftheworkasimpliedbythespecificationanddrawings, even though such work and things are not specifically shown and described therein.

3.19 CONTRACTOR'S EQUIPMENT

- a. TheContractorshallberesponsibleforsupply,useandmaintenanceof allthe equipment and he shallensure that they are suitable for the work and are maintained in such a manner as to ensure their efficient working.
- b. MPT may, iftheydeemfit, direct the Contractor to remove from site any equipment which are not efficient and/or prejudicial to the quality of the work to be replaced by equipment to their satisfaction. The Contractor shall immediately follow MPT's directions/instructions.

3.20 LABOUR

- a. The Contractor shall make his own arrangements for the engagement of all labour for doing thework at site or inrespect of or in connection with the execution of work as also for the transport, housing, feeding and payment thereof.SincetimeistheessenceofthisContract,requisitenumberof labour force has to be kept, so as to complete the Installation, Testing and Commissioning of the equipment withinthe completion period as stipulated in the tender.
- b. In the event of any outbreak of illness or an epidemic nature, the Contractor shall comply with and carry out such regulations, orders and requirements as may be made by the Government, or the local medical or sanitary authorities for the purpose of dealing with and overcoming the same.
- c. TheContractorshallatalltimestakeallreasonableprecautionstoprevent anyunlawful,riotousordisorderlyconductbyoramongsthisemployees and for the preservation of peace and protection of personsand property in the neighbourhood of the Works against the same.
- d. The Contractor shall at all times during the continuanceof the Contract comply fully with all existing Acts, Regulations and bye law as including all statutoryamendmentsandre-enactmentofstateorCentralGovernment and other local authorities and any other enactment and acts that may be passed in future either by

the State orthe Central Government or local authority, including Indian Workmen's Compensation Act, Labour Laws and EqualRemunerationAct,1976,FactoriesAct,MinimumWagesAct,IEAct 1956, etc.

- e. IfasaresultofContractor'sfailure,negligence,omission,defaultornonobservanceofanyprovisionsofanylaws,MPTiscalleduponbyany authority to pay or reimburse or required to pay or reimburse any amount, MPT shallbeentitledtodeductthe samefromany moneysdueorthat they become due to the this Contract Contractor under or any other ContractorotherwiserecoverfromtheContractoranysumswhichMPTis required or called topayorreimburseonbehalfofthe upon Contractor. Allregistrationandstatutoryinspectionfeesinrespectofhis work pursuant to the Contract shall be paid by the Contractor.
- f. The Contractor shallpay the labourer engaged by him on thework not less than a fairwage, which expression shallmean, whether for timeor piece work, rate of wages as may be fixed by the Labour Department of the State as per the Minimum wages Act.
- g. TheContractororhissub-Contractorshallnotemployayoungchildwho has not completed his fifteen year of age. He/they shall also not employ an adolescent who has not completed his eighteenth year unless he is certified fitfortheworkasanadultasprescribedunderClause(b)ofsubsection (2) of section 69 of the Factories Act.1948.
- h. TheContractorshallalsocomplyfullywiththeprovisionsofthepaymentof Wages Act, 1936.
- i. Ifany enhancement intheratesof Wagesbecomespayableasaresultof the implementation of the Chief labour Commissioner's interpretation of the Contract, Labour (Regulation and Abolitions) Central Rules 1971 including an increase of the Wages, the same shall be borne by the Contractor/Contractors. The Contractor shall be responsible for the observance by his sub-Contractors, of the foregoing provisions/precautions.
- i. TheContractorshallmakenecessaryarrangementsfortherepresentative of the Port and/or his representative to witness the payment made by the Contractor to his labourers. The Contractor shall also submit periodical returns oflabouremployed by

him andwagespaid,tothePort's representatives.

j. TheContractorshallathisownexpensesprovideallsafetygearsforall laboursengagedduringtheworkandfailingtodoso,MPTshallprovide the and same thereof recover cost from which the any amount due or may becomeduetotheContractororfromany amount lyingwith themorunder their control.

3.21 FAIR WAGES

- a) The Contractor shall pay the labours engaged by him on the work not less thanfairwageswhichexpressionshallmeanwhetherfortime orpiecework the respective ratesof wages as fixed bythe Labour Department of the State payable to the different categories of labourers. However, subject to the other provisions of any other law for the time being in force in the country, the minimum rates of wages for any person/persons shall be as applicable.
- b) The Contractor shall notwithstanding the provision of any contract to the contrary cause to bepaid in fair wages to the labourers directly engaged on the works includingany labour engagedby the sub Contractor in connection with the said work, as if the labourer had been immediately employed by him.
- c) Display of notices regarding wages etc.:

The Contractor shallbefore he commences his work of contract, display and correctly maintain and continue to display and correctly maintain in a clean and legible condition at conspicuous places on the worksite, notices in English and in the local Indian language spoken bythemajority of the workers stating therein the rates of wages which have been fixed as fair wages and the hours of work forwhichsuch wages are earned and senda copy of such notices to the Port.

d) Wages book and wage slips:

The Contractor shallmaintain a wage book of each worker in such forms as may be convenient but the same shall include the following particulars:-

- i) Rate of daily or monthly wages,
- ii) Nature of work on which employed,
- Total No. of daysworked during each wage period.
- iv) Total amount payable for the work during each wage period.
- v) Alldeductionsmadefromthewageswithanindicationineachcaseof the ground for which the deductions are made. Wages actually paid for each wages period.

vi) A wage slip for each worker employed on work provided that the Port may grant exemption from the maintenance of the wageslip, if in his opinion not more than 19 persons are likely to be employed directly or indirectly on the work but in any case he will have to maintain wage books.

e) Preservation of books and slips:

The wagebook and the wage slips shallbe preserved for a period of not less than 12 months after the date of last entry made in it.

f) Inspection of books and slips:

The Contractor shallallow inspection of the aforesaid wage books and wage slipstoanyofhisworkersortoanagentataconvenienttimeandplace after due notice is received from the Engineer or any other person authorized by him on his behalf.

g) Powers of the Engineer to make investigation/enquiries:

The Engineer orany other persons authorized by him onhis behalf shall have powers make enquiries with а view to ascertaining dueandproperobservanceofthe "FairWages Clause". Heshallalsohave thepowertoinvestigateintoanycomplaintregardingany defaultmadeby theContractoror subcontractor inregardtosuchprovision. ThePort shallhavethe right to deductfromthemoneyduetotheContractorany sum required or estimated to be required for making good the loss suffered byaworkeror workersbyreasonof nonpaymentofaforesaidfairwages, except on account of any deduction thatmay be permissibleunder any law for the time being in force.

3.22PLANT AND EQUIPMENT

The Contractors hall at his own costs and expenses provide all labour, Plant, haulage, transportation of Plant and equipment to be used for executing the Contract, all materials, stores, etc., required for efficiently carrying out and completing the work to the satisfaction of MPT.

3.23 **DRAWINGS**

The list of drawings, number of copies, mode of submission, approval will be mutually agreed between the Bidder and MPT.

3.24 TESTS ON COMPLETION AT MPT SITE

- a. OncompletionoffabricationofallitemsattheContractor'spremisesand also when Installation/final adjustments at site are completed in accordance with the Contract, the Contractor shall give the Engineer noticeinwriting thereof andbeforemakingthetestsoncompletion of 7 days' noticeinwriting of the date on which he willbe ready to make the said testsin accordance withand in the manner prescribed in the specifications.
- b. If any portion of work fails under the tests to fulfill the Contract conditions, tests of the faulty portion shall, if required by the Engineeror by the Contractor, berepeated within reasonable time upon the same terms and conditions.
- c. IftheContractorneglectstomakethe'Performancetest'withinthetime stipulated by the Contractor,MPT shall nevertheless have the right of using the Installations at the Contractor's risk until the 'Performance test' are successfully carried out.
- d. All the newly installed equipment's shall be tested for proper performance in presence of the Engineer in Charge and a report shall be prepared, duly signed and submitted to the Port.

3.25 DEFECT LIABILITY PERIOD

Inthisconditiontheexpression'Defect LiabilityPeriod'shallmeana Guarantee period calculated from the datecertified at the timeof acceptance. DefectLiabilityPeriod shallbe extendable to the extent ofidlingof Equipment/ Facility (non-commercial use) due to non-rectification of defects during the original or extended defect liability period;

Reasonable periodofresponsemaybedecidedoncasetocasebasisandindicatedby the Port after considering the nature and type of defect, its remedial process and scope of contract.

3.26 TIME OF ACCEPTANCE

The supply, deliveryand Installation of the equipment/ items at site shall be deemed to have been accepted by the Port when the same shall have been installed, tested &commissioned and the Engineer shall have issued the final acceptance certificate.

3.27 **INCOME TAX DEDUCTION**

Incometax,ifany,aspertherelevantprovisionoftheIncomeTaxActshall be deducted at

source from any payment payable to the Contractor.

3.28 NO INTEREST ON ACCOUNT OF DELAYED PAYMENTS

AnyclaimforinterestwillnotbeentertainedbyMPT withrespectto any payment or balance which may be in their hands owning to any disputes between themselves and theContractororwithrespecttoany delay on part of MPTin making payment.

3.29 CERTIFICATE AND PAYMENT

- (i) COMPLETION REPORT/COMMISSIONING CERTIFICATE: On completion of work, applicable only for activities under Sr Nos 2 and 3 of the BOQ, the Contractorwill apply to the Engineer along with the commissioning certificate issued by Agency for the issue of MPT's commissioning certificate and the same willbe issued within 10 days the completion of workinal lrespects, after verifying from thecompletion documents and satisfying himself that theworkhasbeencompletedin accordancewithdetailssetoutin theconstructionanderectiondrawings, and thecontractdocuments. No completion certificates hall be given nor shall the work be deemed to have been executed until all scaffolding, surplus materials and rubbish are cleaned off the site completely.
- (ii) PAYMENT OF CONTRACTORS BILLS THROUGH ECS: The Bidder should submit in the consent а mandate form forreceiptof paymentthroughECS andprovidethedetailsofbankA/cinlinewithRBI guidelinesforthesame. These details will include bankname, branchname &address, A/ctype, bank A/cnumber, bankandbranchcode appearing on MICRchequeandIFSCcodenoissuedbybank.

Further, the Bidder should also submit certificate from their bank certifying the correctness of all above mentioned information in the mandate form.

Failureonthepartofthe biddertocommunicatechangesinbankaccount nos.(forreasonswhichmayincludechangeintheconstitutionofaparty due to amalgamations/ mergers/ take-over) or delay in receipt of communications ornon-updation ofbank account nos.may result in paymentsbeingmadetoanunrelated accountforwhichMPT willnotbe responsible.

3.30 PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE TOWARDS PERFORMANCE OF CONTRACT

(i)Within30daysofthereceiptof thenotificationoftheawardofContract from the Port, the successful Bidder shall furnish to the Port, aSecurity Deposit which will be converted to Performance Guarantee, as laid down at clause 3.14 above.

The validity of such Guarantee issued, towards performance of the Contract, shall be up to a 1 year period from the date of successful commissioning and testing of the installation applicable only for activities under Sr Nos 2 and 3 of the BOQ, as per clause 3.29.i of the tender, with a claim period of 2 months thereafter.

(ii) FailureofthesuccessfulBiddertosubmitthe requiredPerformance Guarantee shall constitute sufficient grounds for termination of the Contract.

3.31 **INSURANCE**

The Contractor during the contract period shall provide for insurance for their material and manning upto the commissioning and taking over of the installation.

(i) INSURANCE OF WORK ATMANUFACTURER'S SITE:

- TheGoods suppliedunder the Contractshall be insuredfully against lossor damageincidentaltomanufactureoracquisition,transportation,storage, and delivery, in accordance.
- The Contractor shallinsure with the GeneralInsurance Corporation of India orany other insurance company approvedbyIRDAoritsbranchesin appropriate Indian currency, if any, subject to the conditions that the premiumwill be payabletothecorporationin Rupees such materials, tools, Plants and things ordered from the works till they are delivered at siteand then thosefor the works mayfor the timebeing on siteandshall keeptheminsuredinhisown name andthat ofMPTagainst destruction ordamageby accident, fire, floodandtempests for the full value of such materials, Plants and things until the same to be taken over byMPTfromtimetotime, whenso, requiredbyMPT produce the policyand receipt for the premium. All money received under any such policies shall be applied in or towards thereconstruction or preparation of the materials, Plantandthingsdestroyedordamaged, but this provision shall not affect the Contractor's liabilities under contract.
- Unless the Portshall have approvedin writing other arrangements, the Contractorshall,insure,sofarasreasonablypracticabletheWorksand keep each part

thereof insured as may be mutually agreed between the PortandtheContractoragainstalllossordamagefromwhatever cause arising, until the materials are received at Port's site in good condition. The value of such insurances hall be at least equal to 110% of the contract price.

(ii) INSURANCEDURINGINSTALLATIONATSITE: TheContractorshallsofaras reasonably practicable insure against the Contractor's liabilityin respect of anylossordamageoccurringwhilsttheContractorisatPort'ssite for the purpose of making good a defect or carrying out the tests on completion during the installation & commissioning of the equipment at Port's site or for the purpose of completing any outstanding work and against any loss or damage arising during the defects liability period from a cause occurring prior to the taking overof the installation by MPT. For allpracticalpurpose suchinsurance,duringDefectLiability Period,shallbe from an Indian Insurance Company.Thevalue of such insurance shall be at leastequal to110%ofcontractprice.

(iii) INSURANCE AGAINST THIRD PARTY LIABILITY AT SITE:

- a. Before commencing the execution of work, the Contractor shall insure covering ThirdPartyLiability(TPL) against any damage orloss or injury which may occur to the equipment being shifted/ installed or to any property or to any person (including property and employees of the Port)byorarisingoutoftheexecutionoftheWorks ortemporary WorksincarryingoutoftheContract. ThevalueofTPLpolicyshallbe Minimumagainst occurrence of each incidence. The Contractor shall revalidate the insurance coverageafter each incidenceand keep the insurance coverage till certification.
- b. Such insurance shall be effected withan Indian Insurance Company and in terms approved by the Port Trust & Bidder shall submit the copy of policy of insurance to Engineer-In-Charge before arrivalofequipment at site and shall be valid till Final Acceptance Certificate.

3.32 WORKMEN'SCOMPENSATION

The Contractor shallindemnify MPT in the event of the Trustees being held liabletopay compensation for injury toany ofthe Contractor's servants orworkmenundertheIndianWorkmen'sCompensationAct 1923 as amended from time to time and shall take out an Insurance Policy covering all risks under the Act and shall keep the same renewed from time

totimeasnecessaryforthedurationofthecontractandproducethesame to the Port on demand whenever so required.

3.33 MPT's LIEN

MPT shallhavealienonoveralloranymoneythatmaybecomedueand payable to the Contractor under this Contract or any other Contract from anyamountlyingwiththemorundertheircontrolandinrespectofany debt or sum that may MPT become and payable by the Contractoreitheraloneorjointly with another or other and either under this Contract under any other Contracts or transaction of any nature whatsoever between MPTand the Contractor.

3.34 SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

- (i) If any dispute of difference of any settlement of kind whatsoever shall arise between the Chief Mechanical Engineer and the Contractor in connection with or arising out of the contract or the carrying out of the works (whether during the progress of the works, after the termination, abandonment of or breach of the contract) it shall in the first place be referred to be settled by the Chief Mechanical Engineer who within a period of 60 days after being requested by the contractor shall give written notice of his decision to the contractor, if the Chief Mechanical Engineer shall fail to give notice of his decision as aforesaid within a period of 60 days after being requested by the contractor as aforesaid or if the contractor be dissatisfied with any such decision then any such case, the contractor shall, within a further period of 30 days from the expiry of the first 60 days from the date of receipt of Chief Mechanical Engineer's decision, write to the Chairman putting forth his views why he is not in agreement with the decision given by the Chief Mechanical Engineer.
- (ii)If the contractor, after receiving notice of the decision of the Chief Mechanical Engineer does not refer the dispute to the Chairman seeking his decision, within a period of 30 days of the Chief Mechanical Engineer's decision then the Chief Mechanical Engineer's decision will be final and binding upon the contractor, and no further claim will exist thereto.
- (iii)The Chairman shall, within a period of 60 days from the receipt of the request from the contractor, give written notice of his final decision in the matter under dispute to the contractor. If the Chairman fails to give written notice of his final decision within a

period of 60 days after being requested by the contractor as aforesaid or if the contractor be dissatisfied with any such final decision given, then the contractor may within a period of 30 days after the expiry of the period of 60 days from the date of his application to the Chairman or within a period of 30 days after receiving notice of such final decision, as the case may be, require that the matter or matters in dispute be referred to arbitration as herein after provided. If the Chairman has given the written notice of his final decision to the contractor, and no claim to the arbitration has been communicated to the Chairman by the contractor, within a period of 30 days from the receipt of Chairman's decision the said decision shall remain final and binding upon the contractor. If the Chairman fails to give written notice of his final decision to the contractor within a period of 60 days and no claim to the arbitration has been communicated to the Chairman or the Chief Mechanical Engineer by the contractor within a period of 30 days thereafter, then the decision given by the Chief mechanical Engineer shall remain final and binding upon the contractor as hereinafter provided such decision in respect of every matter as referred shall be final and binding upon the contractor until the completion of the work and shall forthwith be given, effect to by the contractor who shall proceed with the works with all the diligence whether he requires arbitration as hereinafter provided or not.

(iv) All disputes or differences in respect of which the decision (if any) of the Chief Mechanical Engineer or the Chairman has not become final and binding as aforesaid shall be referred to the sole arbitration of Mechanical Engineer serving or retired of Central Government agencies, including Defence Service and or a member of Indian Council of Arbitrators, to be appointed by Chairman pursuant to and so as with regard to the mode and consequence of the reference and in all other respects to conform to the provisions of the Government of India Arbitration Act, 1940 (Act No. 10 of 1940) or any reenactment of statutory modification thereof for the time being in force. The sole arbitrator shall have full power to open up, review, and revise any decision, opinion, direction, certificate or valuation of the Chief Mechanical Engineer or the Chairman neither party, shall be limited in the proceedings before the Arbitration to the evidence or arguments put before the Chief Mechanical Engineer or the Chairman or the purpose of obtaining his No decision given by either the Chief Mechanical Engineer or the decision. Chairman in accordance with the foregoing provisions shall disqualify them from being called as a witness and given evidence before the sole Arbitrator as aforesaid.

completion of works, unless with the written consent of the Board/Chairman/Chief Mechanical Engineer and the contractor provided always:- In the event of the Arbitrator to whom the matter is originally referred, is unable to act for any reason, the Chairman shall appoint another Engineer serving or retired of Central Govt. Agencies including Defence Service and or a member of Indian Council of Arbitrators as Arbitrator and he shall be entitled to proceed with the reference afresh or from the stage at which it was left by his predecessor. In all cases, the Arbitrator shall give a speaking/reasoned award.

3.35 EXTENSION OF TIME

- (i) The Contractor shall commence the works on site within the period indicated in the tender after the receipt of an order/LOA in writing to this effect from the Engineer and shall proceed with the same with due expedition and without delay except as may be expressly sanctioned or ordered by the Engineer or be wholly beyond the control of the Contractor.
- (ii) The Contractor shall maintain the rate of progress required as per schedule. If the progress of work is held up owing to circumstances, which in the opinion of the Engineer are beyond the control of the Contractor such as war, stormy weather and for other reasonable causes in the opinion of the Engineer, the Engineer may at his discretion, grant to the work extension of time as he considers reasonable for the completion of the work. In such circumstances, the Contractor shall apply for extension of time within fifteen days of the hindrance on account of which he desires such extension as aforesaid.
- (iii) The execution of the work during the extended period also, shall be only under the conditions and at the rates specified in the contract.
- (iv) No claim shall be made by the Contractor on the grounds of executing the work beyond the completion period stipulated in the contract.

3.36 ARBITRATION

The arbitrationproceedingshalltakeplacein Goa or at Administration Building, MPT only, and the same shall be under jurisdiction of High Court of Goa.

3.37 DEFAULTS & TERMINATION

1. Default:

Occurrence of any one or more of the following will be considered as event of default:

- a) In case the completion of the work cannot be effected within 10 weeks from 7th day of issue of LOA.
- b) Contractor fails to execute the terms and conditions of the contract and obligations under the contract within the period as specified in the contract, or any extension granted by the Board.

2. Termination

- (a) If the contractor fails to complete the subject work during the contract period or extension period within notice period i.e. 30 days, the work order will stand cancelled, and security deposit will be forfeited.
- (b) In the event of occurrence of default (b) as mentioned above MPT may proceed for terminating the contract by way of giving 3 months (termination period) notice within which time the Contractor will be required to peacefully vacate Port premises and remove equipment deployed by them under the contract from the Port premises. In case of failure on the part of the Contractor to do so, MPT shall be at liberty to remove such equipment from the dock premises and to keep the same at any location convenient to MPT. Necessary charges for such removal and rent for keeping of the same shall have to be paid in full by the Contractor before taking possession of such equipment. Also, in such event, the Contractor shall not be entitled to claim any compensation from MPT for any damage that may occur during such removal and keeping of the equipment at any location by MPT. Also in case of termination of the contract the security deposit will be forfeited.
- (c) During the notice period of 3 months as at (b) above, the Contractor may be asked by MPT to continue to discharge its obligations under the contract which

the contractor would be capable of performing and as may be mutually agreed upon with the object, as far as possible, of ensuring continued availability of the facilities and services to the port users in the wake of gradual winding up of the entire set-up of the contractor.

(d) No compensation shall be paid by MPT to the Contractor in the event of termination of the contract.

3.38 FORCE MAJEAURE

If the Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of equipment is hindered due to forcemajeuresuch as,war,riots, civil commotion,fire,epidemics,natural calamities like rain, flood, earthquake, cyclone, draught, etc.such period shallbe exempted fromCompletionperiod of this tender document.

3.39 LABOUR LAWS

The Contractorshallcomply with all the provisions of the Labour Laws and the rules and regulations made there under as amended from time to time and as applicable from time to time and as applicable from time to time deployed by the Contractor during contract period.

3.40 OUTBREAK OF WAR

Ifduring the currency of the Contract, there shall be an outbreak of war (whether war is declared or not) in any part of the world which, whether financially or otherwise, materially affects the execution of the Works, the Contractor shall, unless and until the Contract is terminated under the provision in this clause contained, use his bestende avours to complete the execution of the Works, provided always that either MPT or the Contractor shall be entitled, at any time after such outbreak of war, to terminate this Contract by giving notice in writing to the other, and upon such notice being given this Contract shall terminate, but without prejudice to the rights of either party in respect of any antecedent breach.

3.41 MISTAKE IN CONTRACTOR'S DRAWING

TheContractorshallberesponsible for and shall pay for any alteration sof the work due to any discrepancies, errors or omissions in the drawings or other particulars supplied

by him, whether such drawings or other particulars supplied by him, have been approved by the Engineer or not.

3.42 DEFAULT OF MPT

Interferingwithor obstructingthewrittenapprovalinthisContract, the Contractor shall be entitled without prejudice to any other rights or remedies to terminate his employment under the Contract by giving 90 (Ninety) days prior notice in writing to Port.

3.43AMENDMENT

NoamendmentorothervariationoftheContractshallbevalidunlessitis inwriting,isdated, expresslyreferstotheContract,andis signedbyduly authorized representative of each party thereto.

3.44 SEVEREBLITY

If any provision or condition of the Contract is prohibited or rendered invalid or unenforceable, such prohibition, invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provisions and conditions of the contract.

3.45 ACCEPTANCE OF OFFER

Contractor shall acknowledge the receipt of Order/ LETTER OF ACCEPTANCEwithin7daysof mailingofthesame and any delayin acknowledging the receipt will be breach contract and compensation а of for thelosscausedwillberecoveredbyMPT byforfeitingtheEarnest Money bond.

3.46 SUB-LETTING OF THE WORK

Thebiddershallindicateinhisoffertheworks, which heintends to sub-Contractors. The Contract Agreement will specify the major works for which the Contractor proposes to engage the Sub-Contractor. The Contractor from time to time propose any addition or deletion to the list and will submit proposal sinthis regard to the Engineer-in-Charge for approval well in advance so as not to impede the progress of work. Such approval of the Engineer-in-Charge will not relieve the Contractor from any of his obligations, duties and responsibilities under the contract.

3.47 SUB-CONTRACTOR

At the commencement of the job the Contractor shall supply to the Engineerin-Charge, list of all sub-Contractors or other persons or firms engaged by the Contractor to work at the Site. Any bidder who had submittedthebidforthistenderanddoesnotgetthecontractbecauseof hisbeingnotthelowestwillbeprohibitedfromworkingas sub-Contractor contract. List of Contractors shall be provided for in theforexecutionofthis Contract Agreement.

3.50 TERMS OF PAYMENT

3.50.1 Paymentcanbereleased under the following terms:

- i) 100% payment, item wise , shall be made against BOQ, Sr no 3 after successful refurbishing and commissioning of all 6 Nos Highmast subject to submission of relevant documents viz. EPF, ESI, attendance and wage registers etc.

- All tools and tackles involved in the work shall be arranged by the Contractor at their own cost.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT (SCC)

- 4.1 The Tenderer shall examine carefully the General Rules and Directions, General and Special Conditions of Contract, Technical Specifications and Drawing and shall inspect the site to acquaint himself with the nature of work local working conditions etc., for the purpose of making his offer on his own responsibility.
